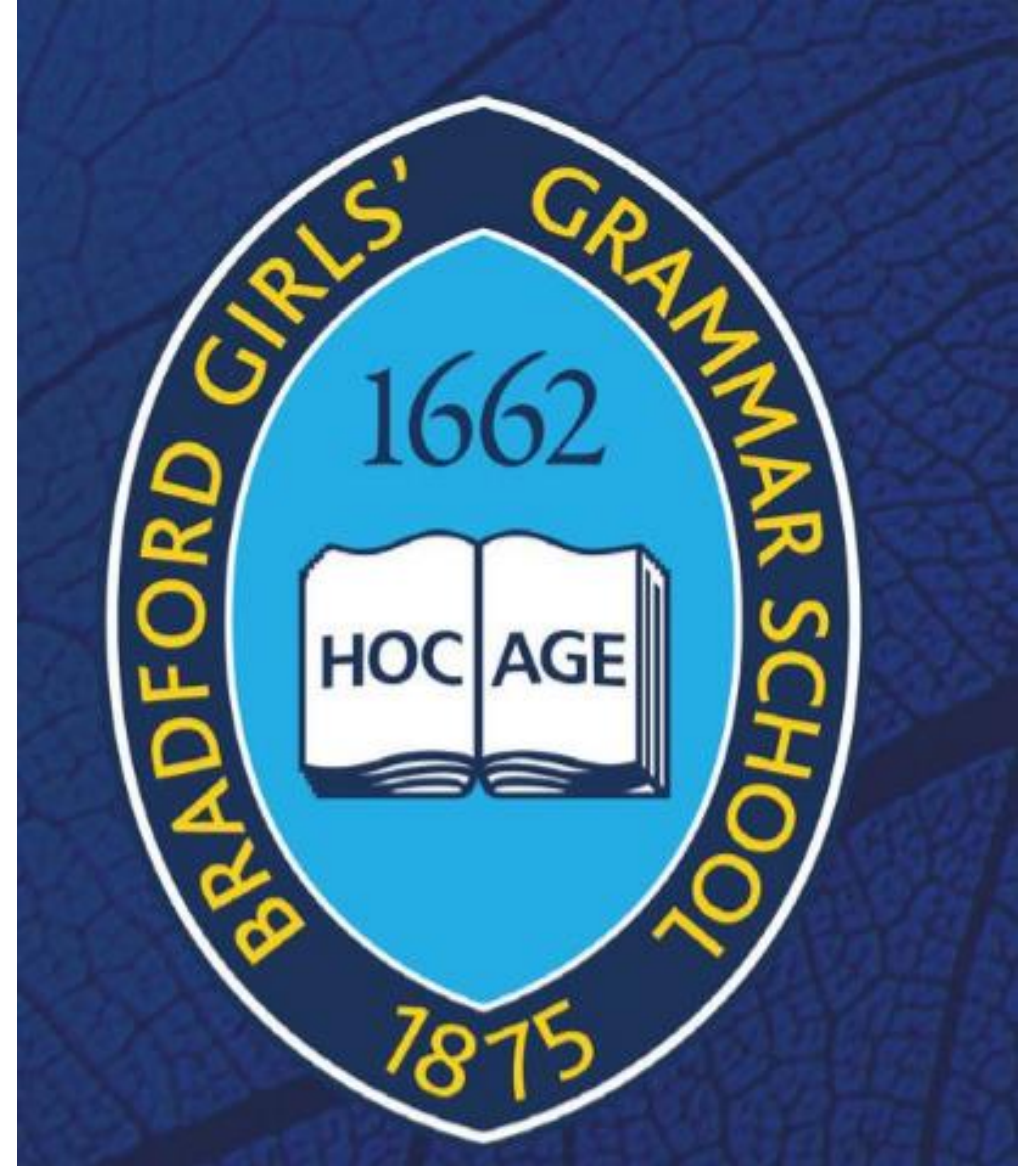

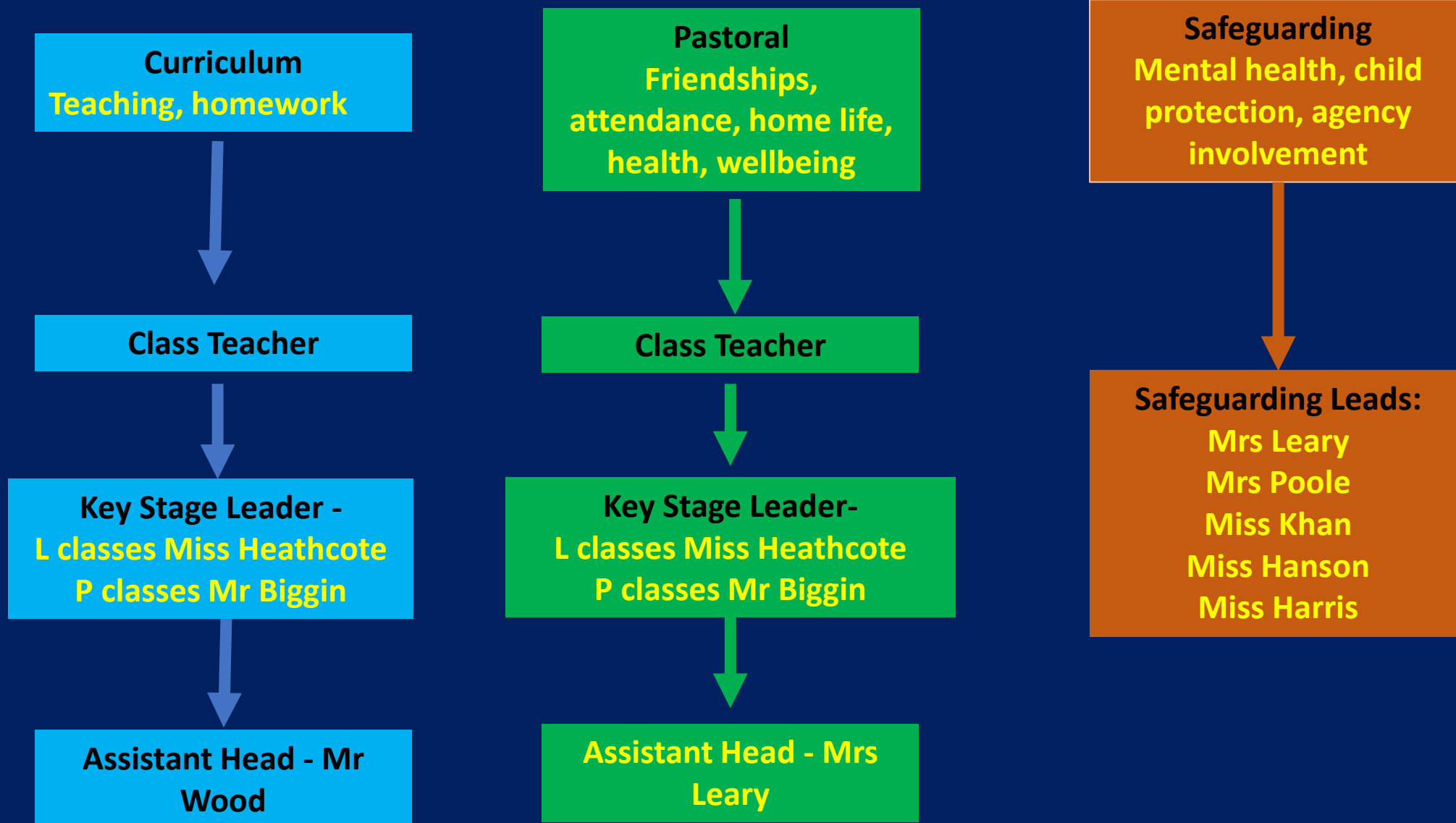

SATs

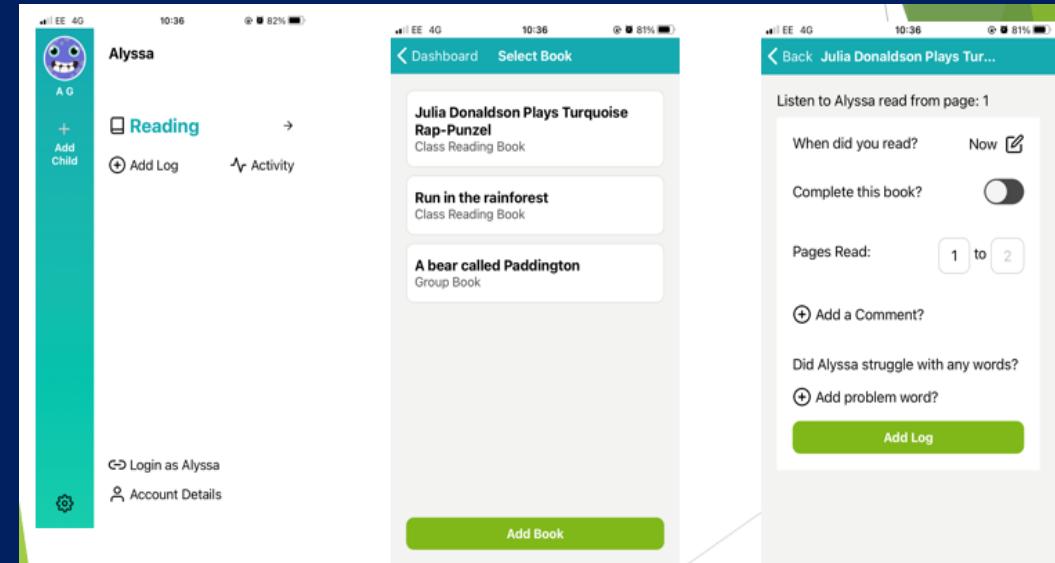
- SATs are due to take place the week commencing Monday 8th May 2022 and last until Thursday 11th May.
- Assessments cover SPaG, Reading, Arithmetic and Reasoning (x2).
- Pupils are not to worry about these assessments! They should ensure that they are completing their weekly homework and maintain their focus in lessons to ensure they are prepared.
