6. Aldi Summer Competition



This summer, Aldi, Team GB and ParalympicsGB are challenging pupils aged 5–14 to design an Aldi lorry that inspires the UK to enjoy healthy, sustainable food through: Get Set to Eat Fresh with Aldi | Design A Lorry Competition (getseteatfresh.co.uk) The winning hand-drawn designs will be featured on real Aldi lorries, which will travel across the country for everyone to see!

The competition, which is open until **Friday 23 June**, is part of Aldi, Team GB and ParalympicsGB's award-winning school initiative, **Get Set to Eat Fresh**. Get Set to Eat Fresh encourages pupils to develop a love and curiosity about healthy and sustainable food and gives them the knowledge and skills they need to cook nutritious and low-cost meals for themselves.

As well as getting to see their lorry design come to life, **the first prize winners will also win £1,000 for their schools**, £100 Aldi vouchers, a goody bag from Team GB and ParalympicsGB, and Team GB and ParalympicsGB athletes will visit their school to share the good news! Runner-up prizes are also available in each of the regions, with the pupils in second place winning £750 for their school, along with a £50 voucher and a goody bag, while those awarded third place will receive £500 for their school and a £25 voucher.

We have received information from our colleagues at BDAT regarding a social media app named Yubo. This is an adult only platform, but it does not have the capability to filter out any younger people who may wish to use it. The site contains highly inappropriate content and raises other safeguarding issues.
