This week's Career of the Week is Forensic Computer Analyst. Forensic Computer Analysts support clients to secure IT systems and hardware before investigating the breach and may work for the police or security services, a bank, or for an IT firm. A range of skills are required in the role including: excellent IT skills; a creative approach to solving problems; attention to detail and a methodical approach to work. There are over 4 500 jobs available in this field in Bradford with average salaries of £49 000 a year.
