

1. Policy Statement

The uniform policy has been created to support students and families on how to meet our high expectations of uniform.

At Bradford Girls' Grammar School we believe that uniform plays an important role in our school community:

- We want the girls to take pride in their school. We want them to represent the school positively and with pride in the local community.
- We want to alleviate the pressure that young people face to wear a particular brand or style of clothing.
- We want to prepare the girls for the workplace; it is likely that they will need to wear a particular style of clothing or uniform when they leave school and enter employment.

All items of uniform MUST be clearly marked with the girls own name.

4. Presentation

- Girls must take their coat off as they enter the building.
- Shirts should be tucked in at all times. If a vest or undershirt is worn, this must be white and not visible.
- Girls must wear a tie at all times.
- Navy blue skirt must be of a suitable length above the knee.
- Skirts must be tailored. Tube skirts or miniskirts are not allowed.
- School trousers should be tailored trousers. Fashion trousers, leggings and jeans are not allowed. Cropped trousers are not permitted.
- Plain black shoes or trainers. The footwear, including the sole, must be entirely black. No logos, trims or decoration is acceptable.
- Year coloured lanyard with identification card must be worn at all times.
- ID badges must be worn at all times, these must be worn the correct way (image out) and not be defaced in any way.



- Students may be asked to tie their hair up in situations which may be appropriate for health and safety reasons. Hair should then be neatly tied up with a plain navy blue or black hair tie.
- Hair must be a natural colour.
- Head scarves, if worn, must be plain navy blue or black. They should be neat and fastened securely.
- Jewellery is not allowed with the exception of a watch and one pair of plain round silver or gold stud earrings in the lobes of the ears. Other jewellery and/or piercings are not allowed. If a student has an existing nose piercing, then a plain round silver or gold stud would be deemed acceptable for school, to prevent the piercing from closing. Any other jewellery will be confiscated from the students, the school will not be held liable for any confiscated jewellery
- The following are not permitted in school
- Excessive make up
- Nail varnish
- False nails
- False eyelashes
- Decorative contact lenses



5. Additional Guidance

School Skirts or Trousers

- School skirts must be of a suitable length above the knee.
- Tight fitting, tube skirts are not acceptable.
- School trousers should be smart, tailored trousers. Jeans, fashion trousers and leggings are not acceptable. Cropped trousers are also not permitted in school.



PE Trainers

- Pupils must wear trainers that are specifically designed for sport. These will provide the correct cushioning, motion control, tread and mid-foot stabilisation which will offer the best support for the foot and ankle and thus minimise any sports injuries.
- Flat fashion pumps and 'high-tops' are NOT ACCEPTABLE. These are dangerous, offering little support or grip and have been the major cause of injury.



PE Kit

Jogging bottoms, leggings, fleeces, and sweatshirts worn for PE must be plain navy blue or black and must not have sporting logos on them.

All pupils must wear the gold polo shirt for their PE lessons.



Bags

Bags should be sturdy and large enough to carry an A4 folder.



Shoes

Shoes must be formal and flat.



Accessories

Hair accessories and socks must be plain navy blue or plain black.



6. Incorrect Uniform

If a student comes to school in the wrong uniform the following will apply:

- If the school have the correct item of uniform the girls will be asked to change.
- If they do not have the correct item of uniform the girls will be offered the chance to borrow uniform from the uniform store based in the basement.
- If we do not have the item of uniform available, the girls will be held in our Reset room where they will follow the same curriculum as other students in the school. We will endeavour to support students to get the correct uniform as soon as possible so they can return to mainstream

lessons. For example, we may ask the parent or family member to bring the correct uniform to school.

If a medical condition prohibits students from wearing the correct uniform, then a doctor's note must be provided.
