To begin the celebration, a light refreshment will be provided for pupils. After the assembly, there will be an opportunity for students to take photographs in the quad area. If your daughter does not have photo permissions, there will be a designated space available in the school hall to ensure their privacy.

We understand that many pupils may wish to have their shirts signed as part of this tradition. However, all students are required to attend in full school uniform. Therefore, we advise that your daughter brings a spare, clean shirt specifically for signing.

The event will conclude at 12:45pm, after which students will leave the school site. If your daughter wishes to remain in school to revise, please contact us in advance so we can arrange appropriate study space.

Study Leave

After this date, your daughter must only attend for examinations. Your daughter must attend in full school uniform. They must arrive through the KS4 entrance.

- If your daughter has a morning examination, she must arrive at 8:30am.
- If your daughter has an afternoon examination, she must arrive at 12pm.

Students will be released from site once the examination has finished.

If you would like your daughter to remain in school full time until her examinations are over, then please get in touch and we will put the appropriate provision in place for her to revise and study in school between the normal hours of 8:40am and 3:15pm.
