Dear Parents and Carers,

At our school, we are committed to maintaining a calm, purposeful learning environment where all students can thrive. To support this commitment, we are making a slight amendment to our Behaviour Policy, which will come into effect from Monday.

This change is designed to ensure that persistent poor behaviour is addressed swiftly and effectively, while also protecting the learning experience of those students who consistently meet our expectations.

From Monday, any student who receives two re-rooms in a single school day will be placed in RESET for the remainder of that day and will remain there until 4:00pm. This measure is intended to provide additional support for students who are clearly not in the right mindset to be successful within the normal school environment on that particular day, and the pastoral staff will work with your daughter to determine the root causes of their disruption. It also ensures that the learning of other students is not negatively impacted by ongoing disruptive behaviour.

Should your daughter be required to attend RESET until 4:00pm, parents and carers will be contacted and informed accordingly.

We would also like to take this opportunity to encourage all parents and carers to engage regularly with ClassCharts. This platform provides valuable information about your daughter's positive achievements as well as any behavioural concerns, enabling you to work in partnership with the school to maintain our high standards of conduct and learning.

If you are unsure of your ClassCharts login details or require any assistance accessing the platform, please do not hesitate to contact the school and a member of staff will be happy to help.
