Expectations for Remote Learning @home

When completing remote learning, students are expected to behave as you would do if you were in school. Our behaviour policy (including positive achievement points) still stands regardless of whether you are remote learning or in school learning.

JOIN:

Join the lesson on time. When you enter the meeting make sure you are in a quiet place without any distractions.

MUTE:

Please make sure you join the meeting with your microphone and camera off. You may unmute yourself or turn your camera on when asked by an adult. You may also unmute yourself to speak and then unmute yourself again when asked.

BE PREPARED:

Come to your lessons prepared. Be organised and have the equipment you will need for the lesson.

QUESTION:

If you have any questions during the lesson, raise your hand by pressing the hand icon in Teams/ or Google Classroom and the teacher will invite you to speak.

The teacher may ask you to comment in the chat but you should only do this when you have been instructed to. This is not a forum for casual chat unrelated to the learning.
