

Parent Survey: 2018/19

1. BACKGROUND

The 2019 Parent Survey was conducted during the period September 2018 to May 2019.

The set of questions used in the survey were based upon the Ofsted 'Parentview' questionnaire which is currently used during school inspections. By standardising the survey, the results can be used as a benchmark to gauge how well the school is performing through a year on year comparison.

A couple of additional questions have been added; the first to allow parents to provide clarity on how they feel the school responds to any concerns raised, and the second to offer an opportunity for parents to provide further feedback to the school, particularly if they have any concerns or suggestions. Additionally, a 'don't know' box was included to allow parents to indicate their inability to provide a valid rating based on experience or awareness.

2. METHODOLOGY

Hard copy questionnaires were distributed to parents at each of the parents' evening over the academic year, with further hard copies sent to all primary parents. Concurrently parents were emailed a link to access the survey online through Survey Monkey.

Response rates have increased year on year - up from 26% (246 responses) in 2016, 37% (404 responses) in 2018 and 40% (440 responses) in 2019.

A full and detailed breakdown of the survey results can be found at the end of the report along with the questionnaire used in the survey.

3. SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

In general, the percentage of parents in agreement with each statement presented was high, with the significant improvements seen since 2016 being maintained, and further increases recorded for dealing with bullying effectively and responding to concerns raised.

Results for Lady Royd were significantly higher than in the previous year, with ratings of agreement over 90% in five categories.

The results suggest an area of focus and improvement to be around the management of behaviour in the senior school.

4. MAIN FINDINGS

Overall, a high 84% of parents would recommend the school to other parents, with some disparity across the two main phases. For parents of Lady Royd pupils, ratings of agreement were 92%, compared with 78% of senior school parents saying they would recommend the school.

For those 13% that have indicated that they would not recommend the school, the main reason seems to point towards that they felt the school was slow to deal with an issue they had raised, or had not taken the matter seriously.

Ratings on how well the school deals effectively with bullying had increased, along with how the school, responds to issues raised. However, it is worth noting the high scores for 'don't know' -13% and 18% and which may suggest that these parents do not have any experience of how the school responds in such situations, i.e. they have not encountered incidences of bullying, nor have they raised any issues with the school.

However, in terms of agreement on 'the school makes sure its pupils are well behaved', levels have dropped across senior school, from 80% in 2017/18 to 73% in this year's survey.

The most significant improvements have come from the primary phase:

This year 73% of senior school parents thought the school made sure its pupils were well behaved, with one with one in five disagreeing that this was the case. This has dropped from 80% in 2017/18.

4.1 Areas Identified for Further Monitoring and Improvement in the 2017/18 Survey

The previous year's survey of 2017/18 identified a number of areas as requiring closer monitoring and further investigation. In particular, these were:

- Parent's understanding of how the school deals effectively with bullying, particularly in the primary phase
- The level of homework and appropriateness in terms of age, for primary pupils
- Communication with parents around pupil progress

4.1.1 Level of Improvement since the 2017/18 Survey

Policies and Guidelines on Dealing with Bullying

Agreement levels to the statement 'this school deals with any cases of bullying effectively' has increased from 66% to 69% with those 'don't know' remaining at a similar level of 18%. The school has made the most significant progress in Lady Royd where 74% (up from 60%) of parents agreed to the statement.

However, the survey still reports a significant number of parents, almost one on five, responding with 'don't know' as to whether the school deals effectively with bullying - the same proportion across both the senior and primary phase. This may also simply mean that parents have had no experience of any incidents of bullying in the school and are therefore unaware of how the issue is dealt with.

Levels of Homework and Age Level

Whilst rating on the appropriateness of homework set was still high, at 87%, there was significant increase amongst Lady Royd parents, with a rise from 78% to 91% agreeing that the level of homework was appropriate.

Communication on Pupil Progress

In 2017/18, 76% of parents agreed that they received valuable information about their child's progress. This has now increased back up to the level seen in 2015/16, at 81%.

4.2 Areas Identified for Further Monitoring and Improvement: 2018/19 Survey

The Senior Leadership Team is continually looking to drive school improvement. As such, all school policies and procedures are regularly evaluated and monitored and the team conducts a comprehensive end of year review of the school's performance across all areas of school life to examine opportunities for development and identify any further areas for improvement.

Although this year's 2018/19 survey is positive overall, the survey has highlighted an area that will require closer monitoring and further investigation, which is predominantly around behaviour management in the senior school.

The results of this parent survey will therefore be included in the review process to help inform decisions and determine school priorities for the year ahead.


