
Year 3: Autumn 2

English

This half term we are going to be Looking at the sequel, 'Journey, Quest, and Return' books. We will use the picture books to write an alternative ending and letter writing. The last week of term will be learning and performing a poem in front of an audience. In our Reading lessons we are looking at the book, 'The Charlie and the chocolate factory' a fiction children's book. We are using this book to learn all our reading skills.

Maths

In Maths, we are learning about addition and subtraction. We are learning different methods to help us work out the different sums and problem-solving questions. Then gradually moving onto multiplication and division with 2- and 3-digit numbers and finishing off with a heavy focus on 2, 3, 4 and 8 times tables.



Can I still use a map to find my way?

Our focus during this half term is going to geography, looking closely at map and compass reading, the changes in how we use land, countries and counties and geographical clues.

In DT we are focusing on sewing. We will be looking closely at the work of Anne Biss and creating our own cloth maps, learning design, and sewing skills.

In PSHE we are learning about 'Celebrating Difference' looking at the things that make us different and why these are positive things.

In science we are studying light. In computing, we are going to learn about stop frame animation. In French we will begin looking at French songs and games.
