# English

Poetry

In English we are exploring poetry and understanding emotions within poetry. We are then performing poetry to an audience.

Information Texts

We are identifying different kinds of information text and their features. We are going to explore information texts relating different organs within the body. We will then be writing our own information text with the facts we have found out.

# Maths

Money

Year 2 will use money to make amounts, adding coins together and making £1, understanding change and compare amounts of money.

Multiplication and Division

We will use arrays to solve multiplications within the 2s, 5s and 10s. We will look at doubling and halving, odd and even numbers.


## Curriculum Overview
