Year 5: Spring 2

English

Our reading lessons this half term will give us the opportunity to learn about amazing. Muslims that changed the world and the influence of the Benin Kingdom on our world now:

In writing, we are going to be discovering the work of Shakespeare and use his work to inspire our own modern day playscripts. We will then be writing a biography about Shakespeare's incredible life. Towards the end of the term, we will be creating our own blank verse poems.

Maths

Over this next half term in Maths, we will be continuing decimals, percentages, and fractions.

Year 5 will cover ordering, comparing decimals and rounding to the nearest whole number.

This should give children an understanding of the equivalent fractions, decimals, and percentages. We shall cover Perimeter and Area of compound shapes. We will move onto Statistics, learning all about reading and interpreting tables including Times tables.

Curriculum Overview

Early Islamic Civilisation

Our Early Islamic Civilisation topic is going to explore the development of the great city of Baghdad. We will begin to understand why Baghdad was such an important city in the Islamic Empire and identify similarities and differences between life for people in London and Baghdad in AD 900. We will research and discover some of the significant discoveries and studies which were led by early Islamic scholars. In Art, we will be exploring the world of ceramics, looking closely at different techniques such as slabbing and joining. In PSHE, our unit focuses on 'Healthy Me', where we will be learning about keeping safe and healthy. In Computing, we will be exploring databases and learn how to create graphs and charts.
