Year 1: Summer Term 1

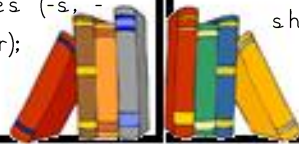
## English

Writing Outcomes:

Narrative - Character: To compare the lion and the mouse from the story 'The Lion Inside' and then write a character description of the latter.

Information Texts: To learn about the features of an information text. After visiting Yorkshire Wildlife Park, we will create a leaflet about our favourite animal.

SPaG focus: Using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces, write from memory simple sentences dictated by the teacher that include words using the GPCs and common exception words taught so far; plural noun suffixes (-s, -es); verb suffixes (e.g. -ing, -ed, -er); coordinating conjunction (and).



## Maths

Number

We are beginning to explore multiplication and division. We start with the 2s, 5s and 10 times tables and creating, adding, and subtracting equal groups. We will also be sharing equal groups as we explore division.

Position and Direction

We are learning all about positional language and turning! We will use words like left and right, forwards, backwards and above and below.

Fractions

We will find halves and quarters of shapes before finding halves and quarters of quantities.

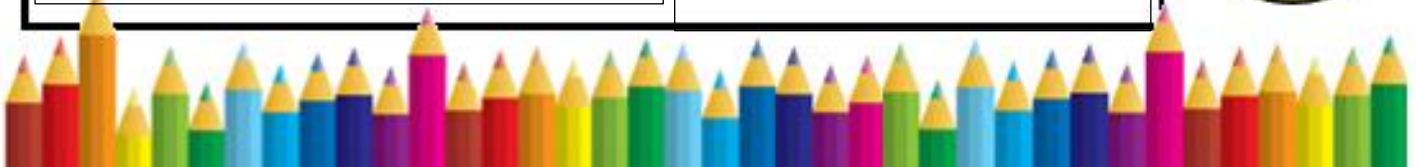
