
Maths

Over this next half term, Year 5 will be covering geometry, number, and measurement. This will cover, shapes, position and direction, decimals, negative numbers, and Converting Units. Children have been completing regular formative assessments to check their understanding. Children should continue practising their times tables regularly as well as completing the weekly homework on Google Classroom.
