

- Liaises with Subject Leaders


## Mr Mahmood, SENCO








# Attendance

Students need to be in school by 8.30am.

Form time is at 8.40am. This is when they have assemblies, read their books, are given notices and information, have a Thought for the Day, reflect on current affairs etc.

Their Form Tutor will check they meet required standards every day:


